**Call to Order** – Meeting called to order at 1:25 PM by Vice President, Kay G.

**Pastor Lucke** -

1. Pastor opened with a thank you for the freezer meals. They have been well received with both the quality and the intention of helping make life a little easier for those who have get them.

6. Hokki chairs: Elaine reported that the middle school has received donations for enough chairs for their needs however the High School would like to have some for next year.
7. Correspondence: Kay will send cards to 6 people who were identified at the meeting to send cards to.

5. Kay requested that a group get together to look at some fleece material that she has and plan some potential work projects for our next Bazaar. It was agreed that we should do that but no specific date or time was set.
