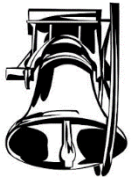

We welcome you in the name of the Lord Jesus.

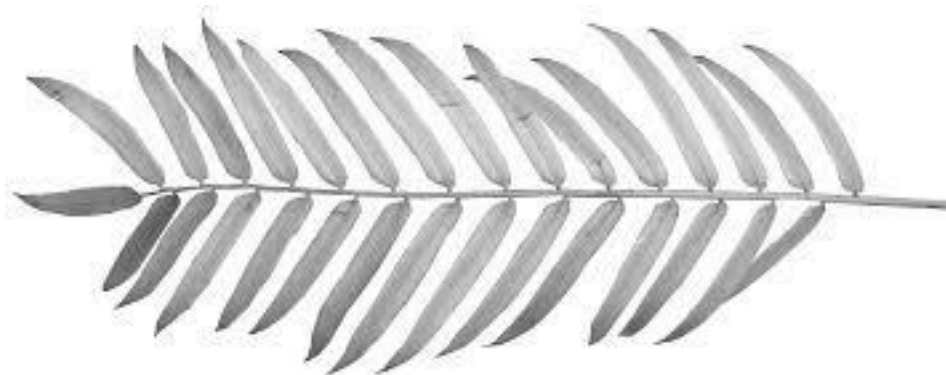

The ringing of the bell and the lighting of the Christ candle mark the beginning of our service and a time for quiet meditation, prayer and inward reflection as we begin our worship.

Children are welcome at our worship services. However, if you prefer, Peace Lutheran has a nursery equipped for children *three years old and younger* (near the piano accessible from the hallway). It is not staffed during this service but has a speaker that will allow you to listen to the service. Good Friday is celebrated on March 30 with a 7:00 PM service. This is a somber occasion but one not to miss.



HE HAS RISEN!! Easter Service is April 1 with service beginning at 10:00 AM, followed by Easter (finger food) Potluck, and the children's Easter egg hunt at 11:15 AM. For kids toddler to 6th grade.

Every year a wooden cross is placed at the entrance to the church, and it is decorated with cut fresh flowers. Buckets of water will be outside and in the kitchen on Friday, March 30, mid-morning for the flowers to be placed in. The buckets will be taken inside that evening and put back out Saturday morning, March 31. The cross is decorated by Sunday Morning!
