The reason for the increase in attendance is that we are reviewing the new 2017 version of *Luther's Small Catechism*. Copies of the new version were ordered for each student. The new version includes new sections including a "Central Thought" and "Connections and Applications" that relates Scripture to important issues in today's culture. Three people are attending with the goal of being confirmed upon completion of the review.

April 27<sup>th</sup> was a joyous occasion for 10-year-old Taylour Veith. That afternoon Taylour was baptized in a private Rite of Baptism with her parents Don and Birgit Veith standing in for her godparents who live on the East Coast. The Veith's began attending Immanuel earlier in the month. We welcome the Veith family to Immanuel and Taylour to the family of God.
