Dear Friends of Peace,

Jesus is coming and will be with us on Christmas! Make sure to keep Him with you.

Ted Laspe learned this invaluable lesson a few years back. Laspe noticed that the figure of the baby Jesus was missing from his nativity set when he was taking it down a few weeks after Christmas back in 1993. In the baby Jesus' place was a note that read, "Jesus is going on vacation and will return next Christmas Eve."

Throughout the year Laspe received letters and postcards signed by Jesus. The letters and postcards detailed all of the adventures that Jesus had taken across the United States. Letters were postmarked from Colorado, Arizona, California, Texas and Montana. Often, the letters came with photographs. A few weeks before Christmas Eve a final letter came from Jesus. Jesus explained that he had been taken windsurfing on South Padre Island, Texas.

Then finally, a few days before Christmas, the figure of the baby Jesus returned to Laspe's home. Jesus arrived with a suitcase in hand all ready to return to his rightful position in the manger. After that particular Christmas, Ted Laspe must have made sure to keep Jesus with him.

We want to make sure that Jesus stays with us well after Christmas. This Advent we will be focusing our hearts on one simple question, "Who is Jesus?" We will discover five answers to this question as we make the journey through Advent. The order of worship each evening will be Holden Evening Prayer—which I know is a favorite for many of you.
