**AS WE GATHER...**The Word of God provides us with great promises as well as warnings. The greatest blessing is saving faith in our hearts—faith in Jesus. But as we live by faith in this sinful world, we need to be warned against being concerned only with the things of this world. So we focus on Jesus and His main goal, that by His suffering, death, and resurrection we receive forgiveness of our sins and live in the hope of our resurrection to eternal life. ### **WE CONFESS OUR SINS...**

P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. Your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the Son + and of the Holy Spirit. Through this forgiveness, Jesus also gives the power to practice forgiveness with others. Jesus once said to his disciples, “if you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them (*John 20:23*).” As Jesus’ disciples, we too live by those words.
