2. Tea:
Peggy reviewed the budget for the tea. Kay moved and Sandi L. seconded a change be made to increase the tip from 10% to 15%. The motion passed. The rest of the budget stands as submitted. Peggy informed us that the charge next year would increase to \$20 per person. Tickets sold out quickly and there is a waiting list for this year’s tea. Peggy will look into having a Buffet next year so we can have more the 50 attendees.

 - b. We need to take down the water goblets and make sure they are clean and ready to use.
 - c. Ellen will unlock the church on Saturday and help Julia find what she needs in the kitchen.
 - d. Thanks to Art Labahn the stage is built and ready to use for the tea speakers and other needs at the church and thanks for the new toilet paper holders in the bathrooms.
3. Bazaar: Kay Glathar volunteered to be the chairperson for our Fall Bazaar. The date is set for November 14th.
4. Margaret Dusek will represent us at the Spring Rally April 18th . Markers, Notebooks, and calculators will be collected for the in-gathering.
5. Janet Randall will represent us at the National Rally.

7. Camp Lutherwood has requested Basket donations for their fund raiser. We will wait for more details on date and time of this event. Discussion followed about sponsoring a scholarship for children from Peace to help with cost of going to camp. After some discussion Kay moved that we offer up to 5/\$200 scholarships, Sandi L seconded. The motion passed. Kay will be the contact for families wanting more information about the camp scholarships.
8. Dottie gave a personal thanks to Colleen for bring her to the Guild meeting today. Discussion followed about being more aware of people that can't make it to functions such as guild meetings and the tea and check in with them to see if they would like a ride or anything else to keep them in the loop.
